How can we protect developments in Artificial Intelligence? Is software patentable? 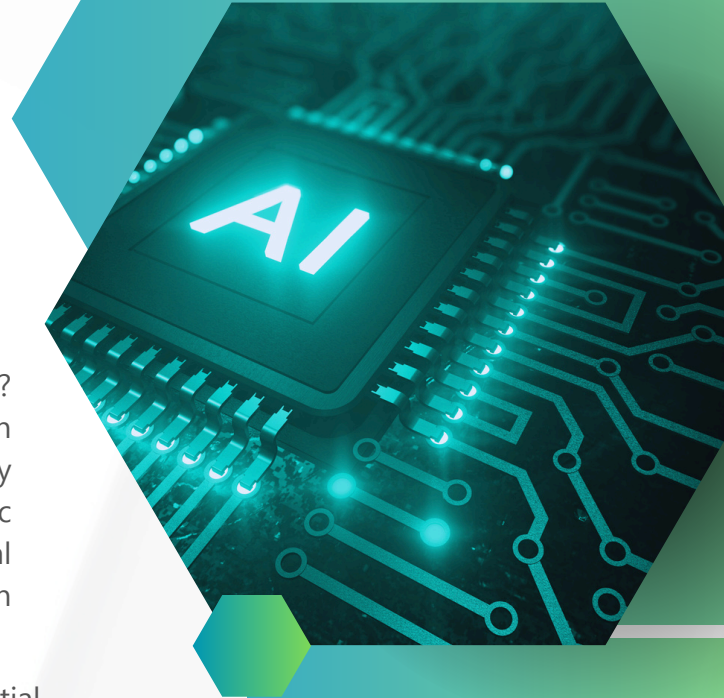
